TEENS: SPECIAL SUMMER READING PROGRAMS OFFERED JUST FOR YOU

Teens can "unmask" a great summer at the Southeast Steuben County Library. Unmask is the teen summer reading theme and the teen specialists at the SSCL have come up with some fun themed programming just for teens.

Teen programs are for ages ten and older. Please sign up by calling (607)936-3713 ext. 503 or stop by the Children's Department in the library unless otherwise noted.

The teen summer reading kick off lasts a whole week: We unmask board games to reveal their super-sized powers. These games become life-sized.

1-3 p.m. July 6 | Super-Sized Scrabble will be held in Fallbrook Park, located across the street from the library.

1-3 p.m. July 7 | Hungry, Hungry Super Heroes. Come dressed as super heroes (who happen to be as hungry as hippos) for this over-sized game in Nasser Civic Center Plaza arena.

1-3 p.m. July 8 | Human Pac-Man. Become the little yellow dude who eats dots and chases ghosts in this live action game. This game will be in the Nasser Civic Center Plaza arena.

3-5 p.m. July 9 | Pudding Pictionary. Prepare to get messy with this fast action drawing game.

1-3 p.m. July 10 | Giant Jenga and Frisbee Tic-Tac-Toe. Test your stacking skills with our big block tower game.

As summer reading progresses, we unmask other great teen programs.

1-3 p.m. Monday July 13 | 3Doodler Masks. Unmask your inner doodler! Use 3D printing pens to create a unique eye mask and transform yourself into a superhero. Finished pieces

will be on display during the Library Unmasked event slated for July 17. Artists can take their pieces home after this event. Funding for this program was made possible by a grant from the Best Buy Foundation.

11-1 p.m. July 15 | History a la Carte at the Heritage Village. Visit the newly renamed historical landmark of Corning, the former Benjamin Patterson Inn. Discover the barn, woodworking techniques and get a taste for recess in the 1800's. Pack a lunch for this program.

6-8 p.m. Friday July 17 | SSC Library Unmasked. Run, jump, shout and have a blast in the library after hours. Dress as a superhero to enter the costume contest. Try the obstacle course, create tasty snacks and cool crafts. Schmooze with special guests. You've never seen the library after it's closed. Now is your chance.

3-5 Monday July 20 | Unmask the glass at CMOG. Enjoy a live hot glass show. Then, take a quick tour of the galleries. Finally, create a sandblasting project of your own to take home. Meet at the entrance of The Studio at 2:45 p.m.

2-4 p.m. Tuesday July 21 | "Cerealism" Pop Art with Michael Albert. Join us for a pop art workshop with writer and artist Michael Albert. Create a piece of pop art to take home with you.

3-5 p.m. Monday Aug. 17 | Celebrate the end of summer with a Nerf Party. We'll have an obstacle course and Nerf guns. Run around and have a good time.
