LIBRARY HAS NEW BE:LAB CAREER DEVELOPMENT & GRAPHICS WORKSTATION

The Southeast Steuben County Library is pleased to announce that it has a new BE:Lab Career Development & Graphics Workstation located near the reference desk in the library.

The PC Resume workstation is loaded with *Win-Way Resume Deluxe* software. Visitors can create their resumes on the machine and print it right in the library. Prints are \$.20 per page. We also encourage visitors to bring a disk or flash drive in order to save their resume for future use.

The workstation also includes an iMac computer for graphics work and a scanner with the ability to scan papers, photographs, slides and more. Again, a flash drive or disk is recommended to save scans or other work.

Finally, the workstation offers the BE:Lab Bookshelf, funded by an Outreach Grant from Southern Tier Library System. The bookshelf includes books, DVDs and other media to help the unemployed or underemployed with their job searches. Our current titles are From Pink Slip to Paycheck DVD series and the Field Guides to a New Career book series.

"These work stations will serve unemployed and underemployed people in our area by making high tech resources available so they can present themselves in the best light possible for opportunities by creating outstanding resumes, cover letters, presentations and more, said Adult Services Director Michelle Wells. "The workstation will be reserved and dedicated to this purpose."

Those who wish to use the workstation should stop at the reference desk in the library.
